Notification

to the Signatory or Contracting States to the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora concluded at Washington on 3 March 1973

1. Accession by Vanuatu to the Convention

The Republic of Vanuatu has deposited with the Swiss Government, on 17 July 1989, an instrument of accession to the Convention, which shall enter into force on 15 October 1989, according to article XXII, paragraph 2.

Every State depositing an instrument of ratification, acceptance, approval or accession to the Convention after the entry into force, on 13 April 1987, of the Amendment of Bonn of 22 June 1979, becomes a Contracting State to the Amendment, too.

2. Acceptance of the Amendment of Bonn

- The French Republic has deposited with the Swiss Government, on 18 August 1989, an instrument of acceptance of the Amendment of Bonn of 22 June 1979 to article XI, paragraph 3a, of the Convention. This Amendment shall enter into force for the French Republic on 17 October 1989, according to article XVII, paragraph 3, of the Convention.
- The Grand Duchy of Luxembourg has deposited with the Swiss Government, on 29 August 1989, an instrument of acceptance of the Amendment of Bonn of 22 June 1979 to article XI, paragraph 3a, of the Convention. This Amendment shall enter into force for the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg on 28 October 1989, according to article XVII, paragraph 3, of the Convention.

3. Acceptance of the Amendment of Gaborone

- The Republic of Finland has deposited with the Swiss Government, on 27 June 1989, an instrument of acceptance of the Amendment of Gaborone of 30 April 1983 to article XXI of the Convention.
- The grand Duchy of Luxembourg has deposited with the Swiss Government, on 29 August 1989, an instrument of acceptance of the Amendment of Gaborone of 30 April 1983 to article XXI of the Convention.
- The Rwandese Republic has deposited with the Swiss Government, on 30 August 1989, an instrument of acceptance of the Amendment of Gaborone of 30 April 1983 to article XXI of the Convention.
- The Republic of Botswana has deposited with the Swiss Government, on 4 September 1989, an instrument of acceptance of the Amendment of Gaborone of 30 April 1983 to article XXI of the Convention.
- 4. Reservations of Portugal, the Federal Republic of Germany, the United Kingdom, Spain, Luxembourg, the Netherlands and Canada
 - By note dated 21 July 1989, registered on 28 July 1989, the government of the Portuguese Republic has entered a reservation against the Indian and Colombian proposals of including new species in Appendix III to the Convention.
 - By note dated 16 May 1989, registered on 18 May 1989, the government of the Federal Republic of Germany has entered a reservation against the Colombian proposal of including the species "Semnornis ramphastinus" in Appendix III to the Convention.

- By note dated 16 May 1989, registered on 17 May 1989, the government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland has entered a reservation against the Indian proposal of including new species in Appendix III to the Convention.
- By note dated 22 May 1989, registered on 24 May 1989, the government of the Kingdom of Spain has entered a reservation against the Indian and Colombian proposals of including following species in Appendix III to the Convention:
