Notification to the Signatory-States of the CONVENTION ON INTERNATIONAL TRADE IN
ENDANGERED SPECIES OF WILD FAUNA AND FLORA, signed at Washington on 3 March 1973

On 20 August 1974, the Kingdom of Sweden has deposited with the Swiss Government an instrument of ratification of the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora, concluded at Washington on 3 March 1973.

The Convention is not yet in force; five States have deposited their instrument of ratification as of today: United States of America, Nigeria, Switzerland, Tunisia and Sweden.

The Convention was signed by Chile on 16 September 1974.

The present notification is made in conformity with Article XXV, paragraph 2, of the Convention.
